TOURNAMENT ROUNDS

TEE TIMES

Rounds 1 and 2 tee times will start at 8:00am continuing until 12:30pm. Round 3 will be an 8:00am Shotgun.

COURSE

There will be a Longest Drive and Closest To the Pin on Round 3 only at the Tucker's Point with prizes presented at the Lunch/prize presentation.

TRANSPORTATION OF GOLF BAGS

GOLF CLUB Transportation will be the responsibility of the Individual Player.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT

The tournament will be a 54 hole Best Ball Stroke Play Competition among teams of four, consisting of a club professional and three of his/her Club amateurs. The amateurs will play to three-quarters (75%) of their handicap of the course they are playing (maximum of 20).

3-5 RULE {USGA}

The Committee will be using the USGA 3-5 Rule {www.usga.org} to adjust player handicaps playing from tees other than the BLUE.

Prizes will be awarded for Low Net for 1st, 2nd and 3rd Team Prizes. In the event of a tie for first place for Low Net, first place will be decided by USGA Tie breaking format of Last 9, Last 6, Last 3 etc. from their round at the Tucker's Point Club. A playoff will not be used in the Team competition. In the event of a tie in the Professional Division, a play-off will take place on, immediately following play at the Tucker's Point Club. With a sudden death playoff starting off #1. This will be announced accordingly. All other ties will be decided by retrogression against the course par.

TOURNAMENT GIFT

The Welcome gift will be provided on the carts at your first round.

GOLF COURSE REGISTRATION

To ensure that we start on time, we ask that ALL Professionals check in their team at the Golf course. Official scorecards will be provided upon check in

SCOREBOARDS & DAILY SCORES

Scores will be posted at each golf course for viewing, on the official Goodwill website www.bermudagoodwillgolf.com.

OFFICIAL SCORECARDS

The Goodwill Committee will produce the "Official Scorecards" which will show the club name and the names of all players with their full and adjusted handicap. The scorecards will already be dotted in the appropriate holes. We ask that the Professional please double check the handicaps on the scorecard BEFORE starting their round. You may notice that the handicap has adjusted depending on the course that you are playing according to the slope of the golf course being played.

TEES

The following tee assignments have been allocated for our Professionals and Amateurs through the duration of the event. Seniors must decide BEFORE the event what tee they prefer to play from and are not permitted to change once 1st round begins.

TEE ASSIGNMENTS FOR PROFESSIONALS & AMATEURS:

BLUE TEES AGES: 64 and Under
WHITE TEES AGE: 65 and over

YARDAGE DEVICES PERMITTED:

Devices that are used to measure yardage only

NOT PERMITTED:

Devices that determine slope or wind speed/direction

HANDICAP/MEDICAL FLAGS

Contingent on Weather, 90(Degree sign) will be in play. We ask any individual that has a medical problem requiring the use of the blue flag to produce a medical certificate at the golf course before play.
